Desired Outcomes

- Summarize evidence-based management of fluid & electrolytes in the dehydrated pediatric patient.
- Describe the assessment & stabilization of DKA including the baseline assessment, expected assessment parameters, & the recognition of possible fatal complications & how to prevent these from occurring.
- Analyze the current recommendations for RSV/bronchiolitis management.
- Describe the use of high flow nasal cannulas & aerosolized medications.
- Recognize the signs of child abuse or neglect.
- Review Oregon law governing child welfare including reporting requirements.
- Provide up-to-date information on how to recognize subtle signs of Type 1 & Type 2 Diabetes in children & provide recommendations for initial management & necessary referrals.
- Describe the initial care of a pediatric drowning victim remote from a PICU.
- Recognize pediatric respiratory in compensatory mechanisms, length of compensation, & indications for intubation.
- Review the impact of vaccines on the incidence of common pediatric infections.
