- Update & discuss areas of controversy or change in the current bronchiolitis management guidelines.
- Summarize evidence-based management of the dehydrated pediatric patient.
- Recognize the differences between pediatric & adult patients in terms of compensatory mechanisms, length of respiratory compensation, & indications for intubation.
- Increase awareness of evidence-based management of needle pain in the pediatric patient.
- Summarize the management of sepsis & emergent infections in the pediatric patient.
- Recognize the signs of child abuse or neglect.
- Review Washington law governing child welfare including reporting requirements for healthcare workers.
- Recognize the decompensating pediatric patient & discuss the clinical & administrative processes for transfer.
