- For the health and safety of our patients, we are only able to accept new and unwrapped items in their original packaging, which have not been in storage for longer than 6 months.
- We kindly request no holiday themed items.
- Toys with any fabric are not washable per our toy cleaning policy and must be given to one child to take home. Toys made of all plastic are washable and can benefit multiple patients.
