After the information session, typical steps include:

- 1) meeting the garden coordinator
- 2) interview with the site volunteer coordinator
- 3) notification of acceptance
- 4) continuation with volunteer program registration procedure
- 5) issuance of a name badge
- 6) orientation with the garden coordinator
- 7) beginning weekly 4-hour gardening shift
- 8) continuing supervision and education
- 9) meeting other garden volunteers
- 10) learning about and participating in plant sales, garden events, giving garden tours and more.
