Course Description:

This one day conference is designed to provide healthcare providers with the latest information on pediatric care. Participants will gain practical knowledge from expert providers in the care of ill children.

Desired Outcomes

- Recognize respiratory compensatory mechanisms in pediatrics.
- Recognize impending respiratory failure and indications for intubation or non-invasive modalities.
- Discuss the current bronchiolitis evidence-based treatment recommendations.
- Review the role of HFNC and non-invasive therapies in bronchiolitis therapy.
- Recognize the importance of treating "minor" pain caused by immunizations, venous cannulation, lab draws and minor procedures.
- Develop a framework for mitigating the negative experience of painful procedures.
- Review best practice guidelines of pediatric post-operative pain management with a focus on non-medication strategies, front-line medications, dosing and dosing schedules, and management of pain.
- Identify common considerations for the pediatric perioperative patient.
- Describe the assessment, stabilization and treatment of children with DKA.
- List possible fatal complications of DKA.
- Identify ways to prevent DKA complications and negative outcomes.
- Identify the current guidelines and key goals of young infant fever work-up and management including minimization of risk and reduction of invasive procedures and costs.
