

Make an Online Appointment for a COVID-19 Vaccination at Legacy Woodburn Health Center (WHC)

2/25/2021

To determine eligibility and make an appointment for a COVID-19 vaccination, visit the **Covidvaccine.oregon.gov** website.

There are two places to get started, both start the same Vaccine Information Tool chat.

1. Scroll down to the **Vaccine Information Tool** and click the **Let's get started** button.

Vaccine Information Tool

If you are currently eligible and you live or work in Multnomah, Washington, Clackamas, Columbia or Marion counties, click below to find a vaccination appointment, if vaccine is available.

In Clackamas, Columbia, Multnomah or Washington counties, the following individuals may call for scheduling assistance: 80 years of age or older, have a visual impairment, or with intellectual developmental disorder (IDD), or non-English speaking, or who do not have internet access. Those individuals ONLY may call (971) 268-5550. All others should use the online scheduling tool below.

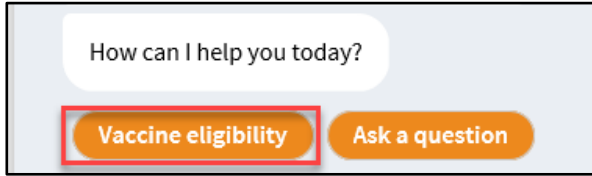

Check vaccine eligibility

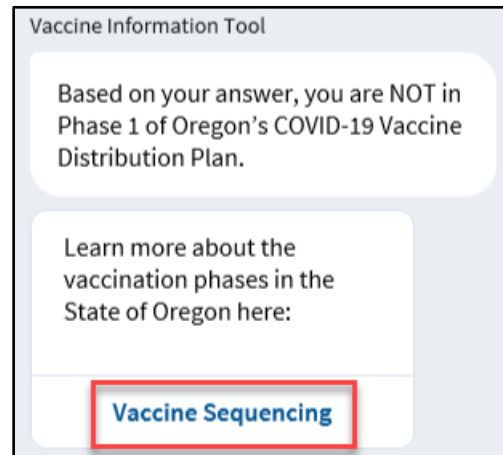
- Click the **Vaccine eligibility** button to start.



You will be asked a series of questions to determine your eligibility in the current phase of vaccine distribution.

Not eligible for vaccine

If you are not eligible, the Vaccine Information Tool will provide a link to the **Vaccine Sequencing** information to help you determine when you will be eligible. Please try again using the same tool when your group is eligible.

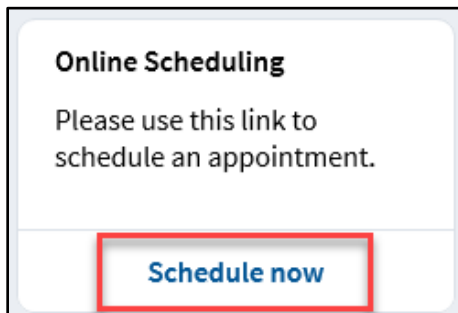


Eligible for vaccine

If you are eligible, you will be allowed to continue and be asked a few more questions to determine if you are cleared for a vaccination.

Cleared to schedule vaccination appointment

- Click the **Schedule Now** button.



Schedule a vaccine appointment

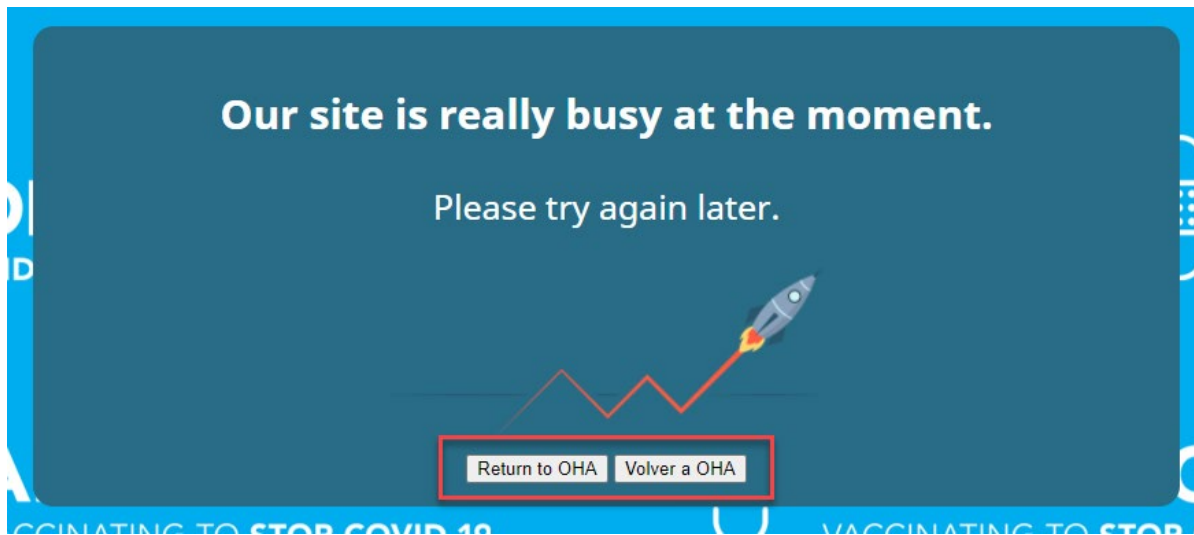
The COVID-19 Vaccine scheduling website will open and offer a selection of appointment days and times, if available.

If no appointments are available, a message asking to check back will display. You must go back to the OHA Vaccine Eligibility Tool to try again.

Access to the scheduling page expires in a few minutes. Do not share the URL with others or try to refresh it periodically, it will expire and not work.

It may take a little bit of time for the scheduling page to load, especially when the system is busy.

If you see the **Our site is really busy at this time. Please try again later message**, click the **Return to OHA** and click **Schedule Now** button again from the previous step.



When the COVID-19 Vaccine scheduling website opens with appointment options:

- Choose a time by clicking on the preferred time.

COVID-19 VACCINE

COVID Vaccine Scheduling at the Legacy Woodburn Health Center

Please do not schedule if:

- You are younger than 16 years old
- You have recently been diagnosed as COVID-19 positive and are currently in isolation
- You have been COVID-19 positive in the past 90 days and were treated with monoclonal antibodies
- You have been told to quarantine after having close contact with a person who is COVID-19 positive
- You have already received your first dose

Vaccines are available only for those who meet the state's current eligibility requirements as described by the Oregon Health Authority.

Appointment must be scheduled online. We are not taking walk-ins at this time. You will need to bring a picture ID and wear a mask for your appointment.

Expect your appointment to take about 30 minutes. 15 minutes to give you the vaccine and another 15 minutes of required observation to keep you safe.

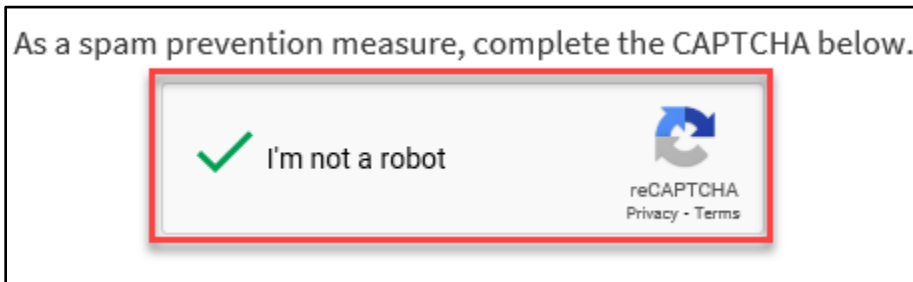

- Click **Next** to continue.

- Find your insurance from the drop down list. Fill in the required information.

Note: If your insurance is not listed or you do not have insurance choose Not Listed or No Insurance.

The COVID-19 vaccine will be provided to me at no charge. You do not need health insurance to receive a vaccine. If you have insurance, the vaccine providers may charge you insurance company an administration fee for giving me the vaccine.

- If you don't have insurance, select "No Insurance"
- Do not leave spaces or use hyphens for ID numbers, include all numbers/letters
