- Remember to keep patients WARM & DRY
- Insert a Foley Catheter for burns > 20%
- To assist you with Fluid Resuscitation:
- → Calculations give total amount over 24 hours using Lactated Ringers
- → 1<sup>st</sup> ½ given over 1<sup>st</sup> 8 hours & 2<sup>nd</sup> ½ given over next 16 hours
- → TBSA = Total burned surface area and is only calculated for partial & full-thickness burns.
- ➔ First degree burns or skin that is dark with soot but not burned underneath should NOT be included in this estimate.
- → Adults & Older Children (>14, >40 kg): 2ml LR x kg x % TBSA
- → Infants & children (<14, <40 kg): 3 ml LR x kg x % TBSA
- → Children <30kg, include D5LR Maintenance Rate
- → Electrical injuries: 4 ml LR x kg x % TBSA; for pediatric patients PLEASE consult with Burn Physician
