Access to Culturally and Linguistically Responsive Health Care

Access to Affordable Health Care

Increase access to health care services for community members who are low-income and/or underinsured or uninsured.

Culturally and Linguistically Responsive Health Care

- Expand the provision of culturally and linguistically responsive health care services.
- Increase the sustainability and integration of Traditional Health Workers (THW) in clinical and community-based settings.

Economic Opportunity

Increase access to workforce development opportunities for community members from underrepresented population groups.

Educational Opportunity

Increase access to educational opportunities for community members from underrepresented population groups.

Essential Community Services and Resources

Culturally Specific and Healthy Foods: Access to Nutrition Education and Support

Increase access to nutrition education and support for community members affected by or at-risk of food insecurity.

Culturally Specific and Healthy Foods: Access to Food

- Increase service coordination between community clinics, community-based organizations, and health care systems to meet the food-related health and social needs of community members.
- Increase access to affordable, culturally appropriate, healthy, and dietary-specific foods for community members affected by or at-risk of food insecurity.
