Blanket Donation Guidelines

Thank you for thinking of the patients and families at Randall Children's Hospital. Your kindess is appreciated by all. Due to COVID-19, our blanket donation process has changed in order to meet the CDC's cleaning and disinfection guidelines. If you are interested in donating new or handmade blankets, please follow the guidelines below.

Disinfecting Guidelines for Handmade Blankets:

- Wash item prior to donation in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. If
 possible, launder items using the warmest appropriate water setting for the items and
 dry items completely.
- Wash your hands before handling the clean blanket.
- Transfer laundered items to a clean hampers or container and fold on a disinfected surface. For disinfection of surfaces, most common EPA-registered household disinfectants should be effective.

Randall Children's Hospital is also requesting that the all (new and handmade) blankets be placed in a new, clean plastic bag in order to keep fabric clean and safe. We will be unable to accept your blanket donation if it is not in a plastic bag. We are unable to accept crocheted/knit blankets.

Please feel free to drop off your blanket donation at your convenience in the main lobby at RCH. There is a flat-bed cart located to the right upon entering the facility to place donations on. Feel free to ask the front desk staff for assistance.
