This wish list consists of toys and supplies which can be enjoyed by hospitalized patients throughout the year. donations will go into our gift inventory and be distributed by staff for various celebrations, birthdays, holidays, end of treatment and successes while patients are receiving treatment. Donations will also be used to stock our playrooms and unit toy storages for patient use while they are admitted, as well as prizes for our weekly Bingo game.

Please note our toy donation guidelines and restrictions:

- For the health and safety of our patients, **ALL** donations must be brand new and in the original packaging and/or with original tags attached. “Gently-Used” items, including stuffed animals and books, are not accepted.
- For the health and safety of our patients, donations should not have been in storage for longer than 1 year – even if they have been stored in plastic containers and original packaging.
- We ask that donations are not gift wrapped nor be combined to create gift bags
- **We ask that donations are not holiday themed, including during holiday times**
- For the protection of our patient’s health, their confidentiality, and their privacy, we are unable to allow donors to distribute toys on the units.

Instructions for delivering gifts to Randall Children’s Hospital:

Donations may be delivered by front desk drop-off or appointment*. Appointment times vary, so please email or call a minimum of **two days** before you would like to deliver your donation.
