Amniotic		Fluid Protecting Unborn Child
Synovial		Joint Fluid Fluid from Arthrocentesis

TABLE 3: UNACCEPTABLE BODY FLUIDS

Fluid Specimen	Reason for Rejection
Body fluids collected in tubes with anticoagulants.	Body fluids were verified without anticoagulants.
Gastric Fluids	The extremely low pH can interfere with some laboratory methods.
Fluids from sources other than the human body (i.e., IV bags).	These fluids were not validated.
